The Chess Federation for Physically Disabled (CFPD) and Tata Steel Foundation (TSF), under the auspices of the All India Chess Federation (AICF), Asian Chess Federation (ACF). International Physically Disabled Chess Association (IPCA) and World Chess Federation (FIDE), is pleased to invite all National Federations in FIDE in the Goa Purple – 24th World IPCA Individual Chess Championship 2025 (Specially Abled)- from 21<sup>st</sup> July 2025(arrival) to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2025 (departure).





#### **System of Play:**

The Championship will be played under the FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss system. A total of Nine (9) Rounds shall be played. Standard, Rapid and Blitz

#### 2. Championship Terms and Conditions

- a. All Players with Physically Disability of 50% and above representing their Chess Federations/Associations are permitted to participate in the Championship.
- b. Each Federation may register any number of Participants.
- c. Every participant must provide an official document to certify his/her disability a copy of the document should be provided upon registration. Providing forged documents can result in exclusion from the Championship. Upon recommendation by the classification committee, the Organizing Committee shall decide based on the validity of the players disability

This event only for Locomotor Disabled persons including Leprosy cured person, Cerebral palsy, Dwarfism, Muscular dystrophy and Acid attack victims.

d. Championship shall be played in Open Category. Where the Prizes will be separately distributed accordingly.





3. Default Time: Standard: 30 minutes. For Rapid and Blitz Full Time

#### 4. Time Control:

- (a) Standard : 90 minutes with an increment 30 seconds per move from move number one.
- (b) Rapid : 15 minutes with an increment 10 seconds per move from move number one.
- (c) Blitz : 05 minutes with an increment 03 seconds per move from move number one.
- **5. Draw Agreement:** Players shall not agree for a draw without the consent of the arbiter before each player makes 30 moves.

### **OFFICIALS**

- 1.1. The International Physically Disabled Chess Association (IPCA) and Chess Federation for Physically Disabled (CFPD) shall appoint the Chief Arbiter, his Deputies and other officials.
- 1.2. The Chief Arbiter may, after consultation with the International Physically Disabled Chess Association (IPCA) and Chess Federation for Physically Disabled (CFPD), issue additional regulations of the Championship with an exact time and other details that are not described here.
- 1.3. Protests, including a disagreement with the decision of the Chief Arbiter or his assistants, must be submitted in written form to the Chairman of the Appeals Committee within 60 minutes after completion of the respective round. The protest includes a fee in the amount of 100 USD or equivalent in local currency. If the protest is upheld, the fee will be returned. Otherwise, the protest fee shall revert to the organizing committee.
- 6. <u>Appeals Committee:</u> Before the commencement of the tournament, a five-member appeals committee shall be formed by the CFPD/organizers. All the members and reserves shall be from different states. No member of the Committee can vote on a dispute in which a player from his own National Federation is involved, in such case, (s) the reserve member(s) shall take his place in the committee.
- 7. <u>Tournament Committee:</u> The organizers will form a tournament committee for the smooth conduct of the World Cup Chess Championship.
- 8. <u>Interpretation</u>: For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. However, such changes/or inclusion will be subject to CFPD clearance. Such changes will, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.





- **9.** <u>Winner Determination</u>: The final Ranking will be decided by number of points scored by the player. If two or more players at the end of the championship (Armaggeddon rule will be followed for champion deciding).
- **10.** <u>**Tie Break:**</u> The order of tie-break: BuchholzCut1, Buchholz, Sonneborn Berger, Direct encounter, the greater Number of wins (forfeit included) and the greater number of wins by black in case of tie, cash prizes will not be shared.
- **11.** <u>Withdrawal:</u> If any player withdraws from the last two rounds in any World Championship on medical grounds, he/she should undergo treatment by a doctor recommended and supervised by the tournament committee.
- **12.** <u>**Disqualification:**</u> No participant will leave the venue before the Prize Distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.
- **13.** <u>Electronic Devices:</u> All electronic items including wrist watches (all type of watches) are not allowed in the tournament hall. Those who are having mobile phones or wearing watches during their play will be declared lost.
- **13. Escort:** Only one escort (Payment Basis) shall be allowed per players.

## One player is eligible for 1 prize only

Cups and Medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first three placed in each category among Open Loco , Wheel Chair, Women Loco, Women Wheel Chair, Junior Boys, Junior Girls, Under 15 Boys , Under 15 Girls.

Three best Federations overall, by ranking of medals collected in all categories among men, women, juniors and girls, will receive a trophy. For ranking, the number of gold medals will be considered first, and if there is a tie, then the number of silver medals, and if there is still a tie, then the number of bronze medals.

### **Accommodation**

- > All participants must reside in the official hotel of the Championship.
- Rooming details : The cost of full board per day/person

### 3 Star Category Hotel

Single Room : \$ 480 whole event

#### Double Room: \$ 360 whole event (Twin Sharing)

Accommodation must be paid to the Organizer of the Championship by the deadline of 30 June 2025.

Championship organizers will provide free accommodation for the Head of Delegation.

### **Entry Fees: Foreign Players**

- 200 USD must be paid to the Organizing Committee for each participant. (Tournament entry 150 USD + Registration fee , Airport Pickup drop, accreditation , Local Transit 50 USD)
- > **100 USD** accompanying persons. This covers accreditation and transfer from the Goa International Airport to the official hotel and back.

### Entry Fees: Indian Players\* \* (Contact CFPD)

All Players need to pay Entry Fee as **Rs.10, 000/-** for the Championship. Players have to make their own arrangement for Accommodation.

- 1.1. National federations must submit a completed registration form together with a copy of the passport. Deadline of registration is 30 June 2025.
- 1.2. If necessary, delegations need to secure a visa to the India. To get an official invitation for a visa, participants should contact the organizing committee.
- 1.3. A medical certificate to be provided at the time of registration confirming the athlete's disability.
- 1.4. The national federations are responsible for the participation and insurance of the players.

### **Other Information**

1.5. A medical doctor for the duration of the dates as stipulated in these regulations will always be on standby should any medical attention be needed by players, officials or other relevant persons in the tournament.
